1. INFORMATION/DISCUSSION/ACTION AS DETERMINED REGARDING THE IDA LOAN REVIEW COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION ON EXTENDING A SMALL BUSINESS LOAN USING IDA FUNDS.

After further discussion a motion was made by Stan Gibson and seconded by Fred Barcon as follows:

The IDA will extend a loan in the amount of \$195,000 at 5.5 % for a term of five years. The applicant will collateralize both parcels of property until construction is complete, the lien will then be transferred to the new building and property; interest-only payments will commence with the first construction draw and cease on July 1, 2014. Full payments will commence on July 1, 2014.

The motion passed unanimously by a vote of (7-0).

2. INFORMATION/DISCUSSION/ACTION AS DETERMINED REGARDING THE RETENTION OF A BOND ATTONRY FOR FUTURE IDA BOND PROCEEDINGS.

Fred Barcon explained the importance of having a bond attorney in the event a time-sensitive bond issue comes before Gila IDA. He mentioned a potential bond issue Phoenix IDA referred to Gila IDA. The entity selected Pima IDA because Gila IDA wasn't in position to proceed with a time-sensitive bond issue.

After further discussion a motion was made by Fred Barcon and seconded by Tim Humphrey as follows:

Gila IDA will retain the service of Pat Ray, Kutak Rock, as bond counsel.
